We are looking for an experienced part-time coach to coach our college women's Rugby team. This involves working alongside a team of three other coaches, running pre-season trials, team coaching and selecting squads. The team plays in AoC Cup and a local College league.

A key aspect of this role involves taking a holistic approach to developing our women's Rugby team—fostering not only technical and tactical growth, but also building a strong, positive team culture. The successful candidate will be committed to nurturing the right mindset among players, with a focus on resilience, teamwork, and continuous improvement both on and off the pitch.

The successful applicant must have an RFU coaching qualification, Hold the current Headcase Certificate and have held a driving licence for at least two years (no more than three points). Driving a minibus to weekly fixtures is an integral part of the role, however training will be provided.

The post is a fixed – term contract starting 24th of August 2026 and to April 31st 2027. However, if the season extends into the summer term then payment will be made for these sessions.

There are three members of teaching staff delivering A level, four support staff and a further 12 part time staff that contribute to the delivery of the Enrichment programme/College sport.
